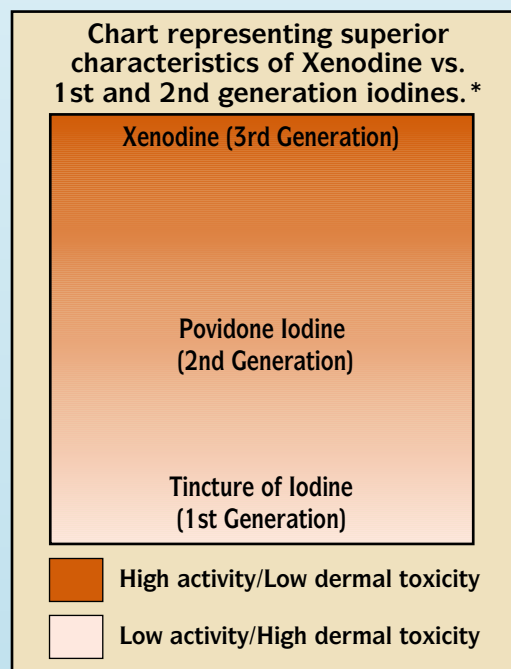

Xenodine is the most active and has no dermal toxicity.



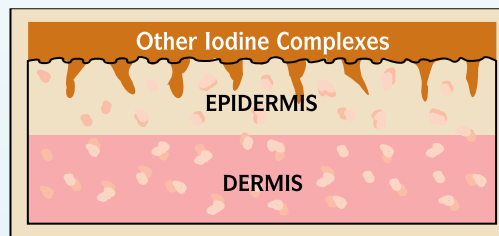
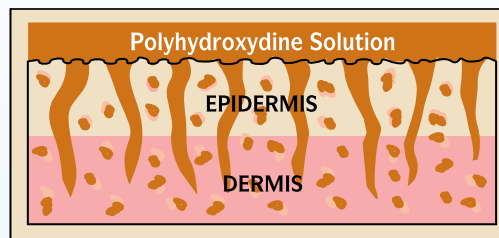
